## European Union for Environment (EU4Environment)

**The Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production Centre** has become the executor of the project component **'Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities'** within the framework of a regional programme **European Union for Environment**.

The general objective of EU4Environment is to help six Eastern partner countries (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, the Republic of Moldova, and Ukraine) preserve their natural capital and increase people's environmental well-being by supporting environment-related action, demonstrating and unlocking opportunities for greener growth, and setting mechanisms to better manage environmental risks and impacts.

Funded by the European Union, the EU4Environment Action is implemented by a consortium of international partners, including OECD, UNIDO, UN Environment, UNECE and the World Bank.

**'Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities'** component focuses on RECP scale-up, circular economy and waste management, and Single Market for Green Products (SMGP).

The Program framework offers technical assessments and RECP implementation at 12 industrial national companies, thus contributing to resource efficiency increase, working out feasible options to reduce energy, water and material consumption, and cutting waste generation and harmful emissions.

EU4Environment activities:

- RECP assessments to identify resource efficiency potential;
- Technical and organizational energy efficiency solutions;
- RECP on-site trainings with the engagement of skilled UNIDO experts;
- Support in drafting investment proposals to attract funding for RECP implementation;
- Business cases on company's success stories in resource efficiency enhancement for dissemination.

Participating enterprises/companies will get international certificates.
