Background

This event will be held online on 25 February 2021. The purpose is to present the “Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities” Project of the “European Union for Environment” (EU4Environment) Action implemented in Ukraine.

The EU-funded “EU4Environment” Action aims to preserve and better use the natural capital, increase people’s environmental well-being, and stimulate economic growth in the Eastern Partnership countries.

By bringing together environmental and economic actors, “EU4Environment” helps to deliver policy and legislative changes, making planning and investment greener, stimulating the uptake of innovative technologies, the adoption of new business models, and the creation of green jobs. Thus, it promotes better environmental governance, improved management of protected areas and forests, and sustainable trade.

The Action spans until 2022, involving five implementing organizations – OECD, UNECE, UNEP, UNIDO, and the World Bank – that will focus on producing tangible and achievable results in line with the goals, priorities and overall cooperation targets defined by the Partner countries.

Building on the important achievements of the former EaP GREEN Programme, where 48 participating SMEs demonstrated the effectiveness of UNIDO’s RECP approach in Ukraine, UNIDO continues to promote and build the national capacity in Ukraine to enable SMEs in switching to a Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production. In addition, UNIDO will identify opportunities that can support the creation of circular value chains and the establishment of Eco-Industrial Parks to raise the opportunities and benefits of a Circular Economy (CE) at the national and regional levels among enterprises, the government, and the civil society.

In Ukraine, the Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production Centre (RECPC) is a national partner of UNIDO in implementing the “Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities” Project of the “EU4Environment” Action, covering three core items:

- Resource efficient and cleaner production (RECP)
- Circular economy (CE) and industrial waste management (IWM)
- Single market for green products (SMGP)

RECP has been defined as the integrated and continuous application of preventive environmental practices and techniques to processes, products, and services, to increase efficiency and reduce risks to humans and the environment.

CE and IWM approaches include the development of new business models based on the principles of ecodesign, repair, reuse, recovery, product exchange, and waste prevention.

SMGP initiative envisages developing a common methodology on the quantitative assessment of environmental impacts of products, throughout their life-cycle, in order to support the assessment and labelling of products. This initiative will have an impact on companies exporting products to Europe.

RECP aims to contribute to:

- Resource efficiency – through the optimization of the productive use of natural resources (materials, energy, water) on all production stages
- Waste and GHG emissions minimization – minimization of the adverse impact of the production systems on the environment and nature through the reduction of wastes and emissions

- People's well-being – minimization of risks to people and communities whilst enabling their development

Event objectives

The event focuses on the following key objectives:

- Raising awareness among participants and key stakeholders on the “Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities” Project of the “EU4Environment” Action in Ukraine, and showcasing its benefits
- Presenting the achievements and plans for implementing RECP activities since 2019
- Discussing new opportunities related to Circular Economy in Ukraine: industrial waste mapping as a means to improve waste management in selected regions
- Launching the national RECP network
- Awarding certificates to the participants and supporting organizations of the RECP Clubs Ukraine
